DURING HIS 200 DAYS IN AUSTRALIA HE MADE MANY
PIONEERING FLIGHTS INCLUDING THE CARRIAGE OF
THE FIRST AIR MAIL AND AIR FREIGHT
FROM MELBOURNE TO SYDNEY, JULY 1914.

ON SATURDAY 16 MAY 1914 HE GAVE A MAJOR DISPLAY
OF AEROBATIC FLYING AT WAGGA WAGGA SHOWGROUND
EN ROUTE TO MELBOURNE. HE RETURNED TO
WAGGA WAGGA ON 16 JULY WHILE CARRYING
AUSTRALIA'S FIRST AIR MAIL AND AIR FREIGHT
FROM MELBOURNE TO SYDNEY.
